Training for investigators and other study team members varies depending on the type of research they are planning to participate in.

Humanitarian Use Device (HUD) – Clinician Only

If any clinician is implanting a humanitarian device outside of an emergent use, they will also need to complete the CITI (Humanitarian Use Device) Optional Module; Found under: *GCP for Clinical Trials with Investigational Drugs and Medical Devices (U.S. FDA Focus) – GCP*
